"REVEALING OF SECRETS": Hasidism and Haskalah in the Ukrainian Lands

The Ukrainian Association for Jewish Studies invites proposals for presentations at an international conference dedicated to the development of Eastern European Jewry at the border of traditional and modern worlds and to the special place of Ukrainian Jewry in the dialogue between them.

The modernization of the Jewish communities of Eastern Europe is associated with the interaction of two powerful movements — Hasidism and the Jewish Enlightenment (Haskalah). They formed the intellectual landscape of Ukrainian Jewry from the second half of the 18th century until the end of the 19th century.

In the second half of the eighteenth century, Podilia, Halychyna (Galicia), and Volyn became the homeland and center of development of the Hasidic movement. At about the same time, the foundations of early Haskalah were laid in the same terrain. Later, in the first half of the nineteenth century, Western Ukraine became the meeting place for Hasidism and a new stage of Jewish Enlightenment — the so-called "Galician Haskalah."

The young researchers' seminar will be held as a part of the conference. Students of MA and PhD programs are invited to participate.
